DRIVE ALIVE TARMAAC RESTORER

Description

A ready-to-use, black water based coating for tarmac drives and pathways.

- Restores tarmac colour.
- Helps protect from water damage.
- Ready to use.
- Reduces dirt/grime build up
- Inhibits organic growth.
- Solvent free.

Uses

Designed to restore colour, reduce water penetration, and protect from dirt/grime build-up.

Preparation

For best results use DRIVE ALIVE ORGANIC CLEANER prior to application (ensure the residue is thoroughly washed off and left to dry for 48 hours prior to application.) Ensure the surface to be treated is free from oil, grease, dust and any other loose material that may hinder adhesion. It is recommended that a test be carried out on a small inconspicuous area to ensure the required effect is achieved.

Application

DRIVE ALIVE TARMAAC RESTORER is ready to use, and does not require diluting. Stir thoroughly before using and ensure the surface is completely dry prior to application. Apply using a brush, roller or squeegee, ensuring that no pooling or ponding occurs. Two coats are recommended, allow a minimum of 4 hours between coats. Cold or humid conditions will slow drying times.

Limitations

Do not apply to wet or damp surfaces or in conditions of high humidity. Surfaces should be allowed to dry completely for 48 hours prior to application. Do not use if rain is imminent (protect from rain until dry). Do not apply to non-porous surfaces. Keep children and animals away and do not traffic until fully cured. Do not allow any run off to contaminate drains, waterways or plants. Do not use in temperatures below +5°C and above +30°C. TARMAAC RESTORER is not recommended for use on permeable tarmac.

Storage Conditions

Store in cool, dry conditions in original sealed container. Keep away from direct sunlight and protect from frost.

Shelf Life

24 months when stored according to manufacturers instructions.

Coverage

Approximately 16-24m² per 4 litre, depending on surface porosity.

Disposal of Containers

Do not leave empty containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals or the environment. Replace lids and remove any containers to a central disposal point in accordance with local regulations.

Health & Safety

- ◆ Product presents a low hazard in correct use.
- ◆ Avoid eye contact. In the event of contact irrigate eyes immediately with plenty of cold, clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical attention.
- ◆ Do not ingest. In the event of ingestion, do not induce vomiting, drink plenty of water and seek medical attention.
- ◆ Thoroughly wash hands with soap and water after use.
- ◆ Keep out of reach of children.
- ◆ Some people are more sensitive to chemical products than others. If irritation occurs discontinue use.
